Steve Tye was first elected to the Diamond Bar City Council in November 2005 and re-elected in 2009 and again in 2013. He has served as mayor on two occasions, in 2007 and 2011.

Prior to joining the Council, Mr. Tye was appointed to the Planning Commission four times, serving from 1997-2005, including two terms as chairman. He served on the Parks & Recreation Commission from 1994-1997, including once as chairman. He also served on the Library Task Force and the Sports Complex Task Force in 2004 and was a member of the Diamond Bar General Plan Advisory Committee.

Mr. Tye currently serves as the City Council's delegate to the California Contract Cities Association, Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District, and League of California Cities - L.A. County Division, and alternate delegate to the Joint Powers Insurance Authority.

Additionally, Mr. Tye represents council as delegate on the Sphere of Influence/Annexation standing committee, and LLAD Council Standing Subcommittee, and is alternate delegate to the legislate standing committee. He is the Council liaison to the Diamond Bar senior citizen groups.

Mr. Tye is a wealth strategy associate with OnPointe Wealth Partners, a UBS Financial Services Team located in Brea. Born in Whittier, Mr. Tye graduated from California High School. Mr. Tye earned his Bachelor of Science in Public Administration, graduating cum laude from California State University Dominguez Hills.

He and his high school sweetheart, Patricia, moved to Diamond Bar in 1982 and raised their three children – Kelly, Matthew and Jeffrey – here. In June 2016, the Tyes celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary. Mr. Tye was actively involved with his children in AYSO Soccer and the Diamond Bar Little League. He is a lifetime member of the Diamond Bar Friends of the Library and a member in good standing with the Walnut Valley Rotary Club.
