The community came out to celebrate at the City's 2nd annual Earth Day event on Saturday, April 23rd at the AQMD.

The theme of the event was centered on education, demonstrating the many ways we can live a more eco-friendly lifestyle at home, school, and work. The event offered several drive-thru services and successfully collected more than 4,000 pounds of paper as well as electronic waste and textiles. The City also supplied 80 cubic yards of free compost to the public. Onsite activities included the popular Smart Gardening Workshop, which was attended by 60 gardening enthusiasts that stayed to participate in a drought tolerant plant raffle. The City had several outstanding environmental partners that distributed information at booths about water conservation, recycling, composting, water pollution prevention, food
