Sustainable Gardening Workshop

The City is hosting a series of free Smart Gardening Composting workshops during the summer months that will focus on water-wise gardening, drought tolerant plant selection and organic composting. Residents are invited to participate and learn about plant combinations that require less water and add more color to your garden. Compost bins will be available for purchase at this event at discounted prices. The price for the organic compost bin is \$45, and the price for the worm compost bin is \$65. The final composting workshop of this series will take place on August 13, 2016 from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Diamond Bar Center's Sycamore Room, located at 1600 Grand Avenue.



The workshop is open to all Los Angeles County residents, however space is limited. To register, send an email to greendb@diamondbarca.gov or contact the Environmental Services Division at 909.839.7015.

Exclusive Discounts

Senior Discount: Waste Management customers age 60 and older may be eligible for a discount on the standard monthly rate for refuse, recycling and green waste cart service. Proof of age is required.

Disabled Resident Discount: Waste Management customers with a disability may be eligible for a 15% discount on the standard monthly rate for refuse, recycling and green waste cart service. Proof of disability is required.

Complimentary Backyard Services: Customers with disabilities who are physically unable to wheel their carts to the curb and do not live with able-bodied adult relatives are entitled to free assistance. Refuse collection crews will retrieve the carts, empty them, and return them to their original storage area.

Dispose of old paint, batteries, e-waste or motor oil the right way at the next household hazardous waste and E-waste collection event on **Saturday, August 13**. This event takes place from 9:00 am-3:00 pm at **John A Rowland High School, 2000 South Otterbein Avenue**. Residents may utilize the mobile, one-day collection event to properly dispose of HHW and electronic waste free of charge.



Examples of items you can bring to the event: computer monitors, televisions, printers, paint, paint thinner, brake fluid, motor oil, oil filters, expired pharmaceuticals, anti-freeze, and fluorescent light bulbs.
