## Holiday Delivery Safety Tips



If you are planning online shopping during the holidays, the following tips can provide you with some peace of mind:

- Have packages shipped directly to a local store for pickup.
- Ship packages to a location you are personally located at.
- Request signature proof of delivery.
- Have the post office hold deliveries if you are out of town.
- Ask a neighbor or friend to collect and hold deliveries.

## Preventing Vehicle Burglaries

The Diamond Bar Sheriff's team urges residents to also take a few safety precautions to eliminate opportunities for would-be vehicle burglars.

Suggested measures include:

- Be an alert shopper!
- Park in a well-lighted space.
- Lock your car doors and windows.
- Take valuables with you when leaving a vehicle.
- Don't leave valuables in your vehicle overnight.
